Dear Mr. Bredig,

Today, I would like to give you the name of the American ambassador in Madrid just in case: Mr. Weddell.

Hochwald writes that he met Mrs. Weddell personally "through a strange chain of events," that "considerably eases" his circumstances in Madrid. Perhaps you can use her as a helpful reference against fears of 5th column activity
